### PROGRESSION TO THE UNIVERSITY

To be eligible to progress to the Joint Medical Program (JMP), you need to:

- 1) complete all 8 courses listed above with an average score of 90.
- 2) achieve a combined English score in ICFENG7000 (English for Academic Purposes) and ICFCMN7000 (Introduction to Academic Communications) of 75.
- 3) Achieve selection in the MSA (Multiple Skills Assessment) & PQA (Personal Qualities Assessment), as part of the JMP Admissions process.

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

• ICFCMN7000, ICFAUS7000, ICFINF7000 and ICFMAT7000 are split over two trimesters (part A and part B). You will receive one grade at the end for each course.

- All courses in the Foundation Studies Program are non-credit bearing courses.
